ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES 802-9390
Planning, budget, community coordination, and emergency preparedness activities.

IN-PERSON COUNSELOR 802-9380
Outreach and assistance to individuals, families, and small business owners enrolling in new coverage options and affordability programs made available through the federal Affordable Care Act.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

BODY ART/TANNING INSPECTIONS 802-9410
Inspections, investigations, surveillance, enforcement and administrative activities on behalf of Illinois Department of Public Health.

FOOD SANITATION 802-9410
Inspections and licensing of retail food stores and food service establishments.

LEAD INSPECTION 802-9410
Commercial and residential inspections.

NUISANCE AND SOLID WASTE 802-9410
Investigation of insect, rodent and garbage complaints.

PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL 802-9410
Assists property owners with septic system installation. Issues permits, inspects and records system location.

VECTOR 802-9410
Mosquito vector prevention program directed at the larval control of Culex mosquitoes. Consultation and technical assistance available. Provide testing of mosquitoes and birds for West Nile Virus.

WELL WATER SUPPLIES 802-9410
Issues permits, inspects and records system location. Provides information and kits for well water sampling, analysis, interpretation & disinfection procedures. Inspects the sealing of abandoned wells.

HEALTH PROMOTION

HEALTH EDUCATION 802-9395
Provides presentations on health topics to community groups and organizations, health fairs, schools, etc.

SMOKING PREVENTION/CESSATION 802-9395
Provides prevention programs and tobacco cessation classes. Illinois Tobacco Quitline (1-866-Quit-Yes).

CLIENT SERVICES

CANCER SCREENING 802-9440
Coordinates comprehensive breast and cervical cancer screening and treatment to eligible women through our case management services.

CLINICAL SERVICES 802-9300

- Immunizations
- Lead Screening
- Pregnancy Testing
- Tuberculin (TB) Skin Testing

COMMUNICABLE DISEASE 802-9430
Surveillance, investigation, education and prevention of infectious diseases that may impact public health, including food borne illness, and TB.

FAMILY CASE MANAGEMENT 802-9320
Assists eligible pregnant women and young children with obtaining access to prenatal and well child care, immunizations and screenings.

GENETICS 802-9320
Provides education and referral for screening and follow-up counseling for genetic diseases.

HEALTH WORKS 802-9320
Case management of health services to children in the foster care system.

LEAD SCREENING 802-9300
Tests children ages 1 to 17 years for lead poisoning. Provides case management with education and counseling for children with elevated lead levels.

PREGNANCY TESTING 802-9300
Provides pregnancy testing, referral to prenatal care physician, and all related services.

STD COUNSELING & TESTING 802-9430
Provides testing, treatment and follow-up for sexually transmitted diseases at weekly clinics. HIV anonymous and confidential screenings available.

TRAVEL MEDICINE 802-9320
Consultation for identifying vaccinations required or recommended for out of country travel.

WIC 802-9300
Nutrition education, health screenings and nutritious foods to eligible pregnant, postpartum or breastfeeding women, their infants, and young children with special nutrition and health needs.
