PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS - GET A FLU SHOT

The single best way to protect yourself against the flu is to get vaccinated.

Our flu vaccination clinics will be held at the Kankakee County Health Department on the following days and times.

Thursday, September 26, 2013 9:00 am to Noon

Monday, September 30, 2013 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm

Every Thursday in October 9:00 am to 4:00 pm until vaccine is gone

Appointments are not needed. The cost is \$25.00 for a flu shot.

Both Medicaid and Medicare (part B), are accepted.

We are unable to bill insurance companies, (Medicare Advantage, TPL) .

Vaccine is available for children starting at 6 months of age.

This year, we are also offering the Fluzone High Dose vaccine for people 65 years of age and older. The cost is \$45.00 and Medicare (part B) is accepted.
