Flu Clinic Schedule

The flu virus can lead to serious respiratory infections that sometimes lead to hospitalizations. The flu is more severe than a cold, it can come on suddenly, and can include the following symptoms: fever, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches, headaches, tiredness, and *occasionally* vomiting and diarrhea.

Getting a flu vaccine is the first and most important step to protect against this year's flu season. It is recommended that everyone 6 months and older get the flu vaccine every year. Other important steps include frequent hand washing, staying home when you are sick, and staying away from people that are sick.
