BACK TO SCHOOL CLINICS

Don't wait: Get your child's back to school immunizations and physicals out of the way early this summer!

The Kankakee County Health Department will be holding walk-in clinics

8:30am to 4:00pm

Thursday June 29th, 2017

and

Thursday August 10th, 2017



During our walk in clinics we are also offering both immunizations back to school physicals, as well as lead and hemoglobin testing

We also offer immunizations, by appointment only, on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays.

We accept many private insurances and Medicaid.

Uninsured or insurance does not cover vaccines? You can still receive them here at an income based low rate.

BRING YOUR CHILD'S CURRENT IMMUNIZATION RECORD AND INSURANCE CARD

Any child under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Legal guardians must have legal paperwork on hand at the time of the visit.

What's new for the 2017/2018 school year?

TWO doses of varicella for students in grades K-3 and 6-12.

ONE dose of Meningococcal ACWY for children in grades 6,7, and 8, received after the 11th birthday.

TWO doses of Meningococcal ACWY for children in grade 12, unless the first dose was received after the 16th birthday, then only one dose required.

FOUR doses of Polio, with the last received after age 4, and 6 months after the previous dose for those entering Kindergarten
