The CDC recommends everyone 6 months and older get their flu vaccine by the end of October, if possible, to protect them throughout the flu season. The Kankakee County Health Department will be having a walk-in flu vaccine clinic:

Thursday October 27, 2016

9am to 4:30pm

Walk-in, no appointment necessary

Regular flu vaccine for everyone 6 months and older

High Dose Flu Vaccine for adults 65 years and older

Pneumonia and shingles vaccines are also available

We accept Medicaid, Medicaid, Medicaid Managed Care, Private Insurance, or Cash Payment and provide flu shots to State Employees
