Acknowledgements

The Partnership for a Healthy Community was established among the Helen Wheeler Center for Community Mental Health, the Hispanic Partnership, the Kankakee County Health Department, Presence St Mary's Hospital, Riverside Medical Center, and the United Way to conduct routine health assessments of the Kankakee County community, identify priority health issues, and identify strategies to address these health issues.



Mission Statement: We are committed to creating a healthy community through comprehensive assessments and the implementation of effective plans.

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Introduction

In 2017, the Kankakee County Partnership for a Healthy Community convened to conduct the third iteration of the MAPP (Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnership) process. MAPP is a community driven, strategic planning framework that assists communities in developing and implementing efforts around the prioritization of public health issues and the identification of resources to address them as defined by the 10 Essential Public Health Services. The MAPP process includes four assessments, as shown in the model below.



One of the four assessment tools is the Community Themes and Strengths Assessment (CTSA). The CTSA aims to gather community members' perceptions, thoughts, opinions, and concerns regarding the quality of life in Kankakee County. This input provides valuable insight into the issues of importance to the community. This assessment engages the community by requesting their input on the following questions:

- What is important to our community?
- How is quality of life perceived in our community?
- What are the assets in our community?

Community engagement is key to the success of any community-wide initiative, and provides residents with a sense of ownership and participation in their county. The Partnership for a Healthy Community conducted a survey among Kankakee County residents in order to answer the questions above.

Assessment Methodology

The Partnership for a Healthy Community participated in the Community Themes and Strengths Assessment (CTSA) through the use of a community-wide survey. The survey contained 58 questions on a variety of topics, including: quality of life, health status, access to resources, social support, economic opportunity, health equity, and social issues. Residents were able to report on their perceptions of health and quality of life issues within their homes, community, and county. While an answer was not required for every question, diverse community input was encouraged. Most of the survey questions asked participants to rate issues on a Likert scale, which is a commonly used scale that allows individuals to rate their opinion. The survey included some questions were open-ended allowing respondents opportunities to comment on their responses. The complete survey can be found in Appendix A in both English and Spanish.

Random Sample

The CTSA survey was developed using SurveyMonkey© and made available online in both English and Spanish. The survey opened on January 30, 2018 and was shared via the Partnership for a Healthy Community organizational social media platforms. Other promotional efforts included sharing the survey via email with the Partnership for a Healthy Community and encouraging steering committee members to share the link widely with their agencies. A Facebook boosting feature was used to promote reach to all Kankakee County residents. A flyer was created and shared with the Partner for a Healthy Community agencies that instructs community members to go to the Kankakee County Health Department website to find the survey links.

The survey was open to all Kankakee County residents and the collection period ran from January 30, 2018 to February 27, 2018. A total of 778 individuals initiated the survey during this collection period. Fifty-five of the respondents were disqualified immediately if they answered no to the first question "do you live in Kankakee County?" This resulted in 723 respondents that completed some or all of the survey (720 English and 3 Spanish surveys). Survey results were analyzed by the CTSA Subcommittee and used to gather the top identified health and quality of life issues in Kankakee County.

Targeted Sample

During the midpoint of the collection period, it was recognized that a significantly lower percentage of men had completed the survey than women. A Facebook boosting feature was used on February 12, 2018 to promote the survey to men living in Kankakee County through this social media platform. The results of this promotion reached 1,045 Kankakee County men. Upon completion of the survey collection period, analysis of the demographic data based on the 723 survey respondents determined that several groups of individuals were under-represented among the survey participants based on the racial and ethnic representation of the Kankakee County population as a whole. The most significant under-represented populations included the following groups: African Americans and Hispanics.

The CTSA Subcommittee attempted to further reach these populations through targeted outreach to the Hispanic and African American populations. A Hispanic community activist was contacted by the CTSA subcommittee to identify the best way to obtain feedback from the Hispanic community. She felt that overall the Hispanic community members were not comfortable with taking an electronic survey. She agreed to take paper copies of the survey in both Spanish and English to the homes of people that she knew or were recommended to her throughout the Hispanic community. She selected individuals that would geographically represent the Hispanic populations within Kankakee County in the following areas: Manteno, Pembroke, Momence, and the city of Kankakee. Twenty surveys were completed through this targeted outreach method.

The CTSA subcommittee reached out to the President of the Kankakee Area National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) to see if survey sampling could be completed at a monthly membership meeting. The president agreed to add the survey as an agenda item at the April 12th, 2018 meeting. The CTSA subcommittee also took surveys to a Presence St Mary's Fit N' Healthy exercise class on April 12th, 2018. Subcommittee members took paper copies of the survey in English to these two events and were able to have 16 surveys completed. Target sampling at these events were able to provide feedback from the African American community members of Kankakee County. See Appendices C for analysis of targeted sample data.

Health Equity

Questions addressing health equity were included in the survey to measure the effects of discrimination on health. Respondents were asked to identify perceptions of discrimination in Kankakee County. These questions were adapted from "Experiences of discrimination: Validity and reliability of a self-report measure for population health research on racism and health."

Data Limitations

While efforts were made for survey respondents to generally reflect Kankakee County residents, it is important to note that the sample is not a representative sample.

Executive Summary: Key Findings from the Community Themes and Strengths Assessment

A community survey open to all Kankakee County residents was conducted from January 30, 2018 to February 27, 2018. As a result, 723 responses were elicited from the community, answering questions on their perceptions of their quality of life, social issues, health issues, and access to health care.

The majority of respondents in this survey are white, non-Hispanic women over the age 35 years of age, and are not a representative sample of Kankakee County as a whole. Responses were recorded from every zip code in Kankakee County except Union Hill (60969) and Hopkins Park (60944). The majority of respondents have lived in Kankakee County longer than 16 years.

The majority of respondents perceive life in Kankakee County "good" or "fair" for overall quality of life, "very good" or "good" for quality of environment, and "very good" or "good" for quality of healthcare. The majority of respondents perceive Kankakee County as a "fair" or "good" place to raise children, grow old, and view Kankakee County as a safe community. Comments related to quality of life indicate social concerns related to safety and crime, education, and access to healthcare.

Most respondents rate that they have enough money to pay for needed items (e.g. food, clothing, housing, and medicine), have people they can get help from when needed, and have a sense of responsibility to help improve the health of their community. Respondents rated low to having a sense of community pride and there being enough jobs in Kankakee County.

Respondents identified areas in which they have experienced any type of discrimination in Kankakee County. The top three areas in which respondents experienced discrimination are at work (35.7%), on the street/ in a pubic setting (32.3%), and getting hired/ getting a job (25%). Additional perceptions of discrimination that were shared through comments are racial discrimination, discrimination against women, and discrimination within the school setting.

Respondents identified social issues of important concern for community residents. Access to interpreter services was identified as the most important social concern for residents in their home and in their neighborhood or community. These results may be less valid since respondents were not given the option of "not applicable," even if interpreter services were not needed in their home or neighborhood/ community. Other top social issues of concern for respondents were living in a safe neighborhood, being able to find good jobs and living in a healthy economy, and the ability to participate in arts, culture, and community events. Respondents comments related to this issue include safety, high healthcare costs, and lack of diversity within Kankakee County.

Respondents identified significant health concerns including depression/ anxiety, other mental health issues, and dementia/Alzheimer's disease for residents in their home. Most respondents

identify youth violence, underage drinking, and illegal drug use as the most significant health issues within their neighborhood or community. The majority of respondents commented on the lack of resources, violence, and bullying as additional health concerns.

The survey captured valuable data on where community members obtain their health information and services within the Kankakee County health system. Most respondents receive health information from a variety of sources, including the internet, their healthcare provider, the newspaper (in print or online), and family. Most respondents visit their private practice healthcare provider for routine health care or sick care (83.1%), mental health services (85.7% of those seeking services), dental services (96.7%), and prenatal (pregnancy) services (96.8% of those seeking services). Many respondents (77.4%) also visit immediate care/ fast care clinics and hospital emergency rooms when they are sick or need medical care. A significant portion of respondent's comments included seeking a variety of healthcare services outside of Kankakee County.

There was a significant lack of representation among the African American and Hispanic community members among the survey sample. A Hispanic community activist reached out and obtained 20 surveys from Hispanic community members across several areas in Kankakee County. The overall themes identified from this targeted sample include low quality of life for growing old in Kankakee County, lack of jobs, high costs of healthcare, and low access to adequate healthcare. This targeted sample also identifies a higher rate of experiencing discrimination than the larger sample. Significant social concerns for this group include being able to find good jobs and practicing healthy behaviors among adults. Significant health concerns for this group include underage drinking and dementia/ Alzheimer's disease.

A targeted sample among African Americans at several local events on April 12, 2018, which resulted in 16 surveys completed. Quality of life related to the environment and the healthcare system are rated low among this targeted sample. Overall, this group rated experiencing discrimination as higher than the larger sample, and rated experiencing discrimination on the street/ public setting and getting services at a restaurant or store as significantly higher than other settings. The most significant social concerns for this targeted sample is being able to find good jobs. Violence and other mental health issues are the most significant health concerns among these respondents. Access to healthcare among this targeted sample is similar to the larger sample.

The following themes were identified by survey respondents as perceived issues that need to be addressed in Kankakee County:


- Discrimination
- Healthcare: High cost and lack of access
- High rates of crime, violence, and bullying
- Jobs: Lack of jobs and low-wage jobs
- Lack of diversity
- Mental illness and substance abuse





The chart above displays Kankakee County census demographics compared to the community survey sample results. In comparison with Kankakee County census demographics, the survey sample does not represent all Kankakee County residents. However, there are similarities with categories such as race/ethnicity and education. The community survey elicited 778 responses in total. Overall, the survey sample had a large number of female respondents (81%) compared to the 51% living in Kankakee County. Most survey respondents were white (91.5%) which is similar to the composition of Kankakee County at 81.2%. Forty five percent of the respondents were 44 years of age or younger, and 54% were 45 years and older.


Of the respondents surveyed, the majority (62.5%) are married or in a civil union while 21.1% of respondents are single. Seventy percent of the respondents have lived in Kankakee County for 16 years or more. Half of the respondents have an annual gross income of \$35,000 to \$99,999. The median income for Kankakee County is \$54,697. See the graphs below for more detailed demographic information.








Survey responses were recorded from 90% of the zip codes within Kankakee County. The zip code with the highest survey participation was 60914, Bourbonnais, with 39.4% of the respondents, which is 16.4% of the county population. The second highest was the city of Kankakee 25.1% of the respondents, which is 24.2% of the county population.




Community Themes and Strengths Findings

Quality of Life

For this section of the survey, respondents were asked a series of questions about the quality of life in Kankakee County, and were asked to mark the rating which most closely matched their opinion.



When asked about the overall quality of life in Kankakee County, 60% of respondents selected good or very good. Sixty five percent of respondents rated the overall quality of the environment (such as indoor/outdoor air, land, and water) as good or very good. Of the 617 that responded to this question, 55% rated the healthcare system in Kankakee County as good or very good.



When asked how to rate Kankakee County as a place to raise children, 53% of the respondents selected good or very good. Only 44% of respondents rated Kankakee County as a good or very good place to grow old, while 53% rated this question as fair or poor. Forty seven percent of the respondents rated Kankakee County as a safe place to live as "good" or "very good."

Open Responses

Of the respondents, 206 provided comments to further explain their selections to the above questions. Analysis of the responses identified several themes within the responses, as listed below:

Safety and Crime


The largest percentage (37.4%) of responses reflected the issue of feeling safe in their neighborhood or in parts of the county, and the prevalence of crime in Kankakee County. Gun violence, drugs, and gang activity, particularly in the city of Kankakee, is of significant concern to many of the respondents.

Education

Around 6% of the respondents identified the education system within Kankakee County as a concern. Several respondents said that the quality of education is different based on location within the county. Lack of funding for school improvement and to adequately address the needs of students was also mentioned as a concern among several respondents.

Access to Healthcare

Nearly 4% of the responses addressed barriers to healthcare services. These barriers include high costs of healthcare in this area, transportation to healthcare services for individuals living in rural areas of the county, healthcare for older adults, and acceptance of various types of health insurance, including state and private insurance.



When asked if respondents had enough money to pay for the things they really need, 83% selected "always" or "most of the time." Seventy one percent of the respondents selected that they can get help when needed "always" or "most of the time." Respondents stated that in the past year, 82% were able to get the health services they needed "always" or "most of the time."

Open Responses

Of the respondents, 130 provided comments to further explain their selections to the above questions. Analysis of the responses identified several themes within the responses, as listed below:

Low-wage Jobs

Nearly 14% of the respondents identified low-wage jobs as a significant issue that impact the quality of life in Kankakee County. It was noted in the responses that many of the jobs available are low paying and do not offer benefits. Several individuals described having a job that does not pay enough to support their family or having to work multiple jobs to earn enough.

Lack of Jobs


Lack of jobs (11.5%) was identified as a significant issue for respondents. Respondents identified the need for more businesses and manufacturing companies in Kankakee County that can provide more jobs to Kankakee County residents.

Lack of skilled workers

Nearly 4% of the respondents identified that there are not enough individuals that require the skills needed to obtain and keep a job. An increase in programs and education to build skills was noted as a solution to this issue.

Health Equity

An important aspect of identifying the strengths and themes within a community related to health equity is to assess perceptions of discrimination. Respondents were asked to identify areas in which they have experienced any type of discrimination in Kankakee County. The top three areas in which respondents experienced discrimination one or more times is at work (35.7%), on the street or in a pubic setting (32.3%), and getting hired/getting a job (25%).



Respondents were asked again within the survey if they have ever experienced discrimination. Within their home, 82.9% rarely or never experienced discrimination. Close to 46% of respondents rated that residents experience discrimination rarely or never in their neighborhood or community. The perception of discrimination beyond their community is much higher, with 12.1% of respondents rating "rarely" of "never" to residents experiencing discrimination in Kankakee County.

Open Responses

Of the respondents, 96 provided comments further explain their selections to the above questions. Analysis of the responses identified several themes within the responses, as listed below:

Discrimination in the school setting

Several respondents (9.4%) commented on discrimination including bullying and racial discrimination among students and with hiring practices within the school system.

Discrimination against race

Close to 8% of the respondents commented on experiences of racial discrimination within Kankakee County. Among these comments, respondents mentioned experiencing discrimination related to interracial families. Several respondents commented on racial discrimination being an issue for Kankakee County as a whole, and in areas within the county.

Discrimination against women

Around 6% of the respondents identified discrimination against women living in Kankakee County. Examples provided in these responses include women being less respected than men in the workplace setting and wage differences.

Social Issues

Respondents were asked to rate social issues in their home, their neighborhood or community, and in Kankakee County. Each question was rated as always, most of the time, sometimes, rarely, and never. Issues that are ranked low in the always or most of the time category indicate that these are significant concerns to the residents of Kankakee County. Access to interpreter services was identified as the most important social concern for residents in their home and in their neighborhood or community. These results may be less valid, since they were not given the option of not applicable, even if interpreter services were not needed in their home or neighborhood/ community. Respondents rated being able to live in a safe neighborhood as the primary social concern for Kankakee County as a whole. Being able to find good jobs and live in a healthy economy was the second most important social issue for respondents in all three

settings, their home, neighborhood/community, and in Kankakee County. The third most important significant social concern for residents in their home is the ability to participate in arts, culture, and community events. See the table below for detailed information about the






The next three charts provide detailed information about all of the social issues that respondents rated in the survey. It is important to identify the social issues that respondents rate highest (always or most of the time), indicating these issues are of the least concern. Respondents indicated that in their home and in their neighborhood or community, access to immunizations and living in a family-friendly environment were rated as the highest social issues. Having transportation was the third highest issue for residents in their home. In the neighborhood or community, living in a clean environment was rated the third highest. For

Kankakee County, respondents rated participation in recreational activities, access to immunizations, and access to healthy foods are the top three highest rated social issues.







Open Responses

Of the respondents, 79 provided comments further explain their selections to the above questions. It is important to note that the largest percentage of respondents (8.9%) provided comments related to difficulty determining what social issues are impacting individuals outside of their home or Kankakee County. Several comments suggested adding "not applicable" as an optional response category. Analysis of the responses identified several themes within the responses, as listed below:

Healthcare

Around 10% of respondents identify healthcare as a significant issue within Kankakee County. Comments related to healthcare include the high cost as a barrier to access and the high rate of residents that qualify for state insurance, Medicaid.

Safety

Close to 8% of the survey respondents commented on safety as a significant social issue. Several of the respondents mention the feeling of safety of within their home or neighborhood/community. Several respondents commented on the concerns for environmental safety within Kankakee County.

Lack of Diversity

Around 5% of the respondents commented on the lack of diversity within Kankakee County. Commented related to this social issue include not having an appreciation for diversity within the county and the need for increased diversity, more appreciated for diversity, and diversity training.

Health Issues


Respondents were asked to rate health issues in their home, their neighborhood or community, and in Kankakee County. Each question was rated as not a problem, a small problem, somewhat a problem, a large problem, and don't know/not applicable. Issues that are ranked high the categories of somewhat a problem or a large problem indicate that these are significant health concerns for the residents of Kankakee County. The top three health concerns for residents in their homes is depression/ anxiety, other mental health issues, and dementia/Alzheimer's disease. In their neighborhood or community, respondents indicated that youth violence, underage drinking, and illegal drug use are the most significant health issues. The respondents rated illegal drug use, domestic abuse, and dementia/ Alzheimer's disease as the to three health concerns in Kankakee County as a whole. See the chart below for detailed information. It is important to note that the percentage of respondents that identify health issues as primary


concerns in their home are rage from 2%-10.4% and increase significantly to 36.8%-44.5% in the neighborhood/ community, and then nearly double to 76.6%-95.8% for Kankakee County.

The charts below provide detailed information on all health issues the respondents were asked to rate on the survey. The health issues that were rated the lowest in each of the categories indicates respondents are the least concerned with these health issues. In the home, respondents rated the lowest health issues as violence, underage drinking, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs). Respondents rated the lowest in the neighborhood or community violence, dementia/ Alzheimer's disease, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs). Violence

and underage drinking are noted to be of least concern to the respondents for Kankakee County, along with youth violence, bullying/gangs.





Open Responses

Of the respondents, 61 provided comments further explain their selections to the above questions about health issues. Analysis of the responses identified several themes within the responses, as listed below:

Lack of Resources

Around 18% if the respondents commented on the lack of community resources available to Kankakee County residents. The majority of individuals commented on the lack of mental health services. Several individuals commented on the need for increased services to prevent and treat substance abuse.

Violence

Violence was a common theme among 8% of the respondents. Comments with this theme include a general impression of violence in Kankakee County, or in specific areas on the county.


Bullying

Close to 8% of respondents commented on bullying. Most of the respondents commented on their children experiencing bullying in the school setting.

Information and Services

Resources


Respondents were asked to select where they get health related information. The top five resources that were selected include the internet (62.8%), their healthcare provider (59%), the newspaper (in print or online) (45.8%), the hospital (40.4%), and family (36%).




Access to Health Care

Having adequate access to health care is important for individuals to receive preventative health care and treatment of diseases, illness, and injuries. Respondents were asked to select where they go for health care services. The highest three places that individuals access health care are their healthcare provider (83.1%), Immediate care/ fast care clinic (46.1%), and the


hospital emergency department (30.7%). Close to 5% of the respondents selected "other" for health care services, and gave comments for options other than those provided: going out of county (up north or Cook County) and not being able to afford health care services.




Adequate access to mental health care is important to the mental health and well-being for individuals who need mental health services. The majority of respondents (57.4%) selected not applicable for this question. Of those that responded, the highest percentage of individuals selected private practice/ healthcare provider (36%). A much smaller percentage of individuals selected the hospital emergency department (5.5%). Close to 5% of the respondents selected "other," and included the following comments: unable to afford mental health services, church, another county, KC-CASA.



Dental health is an important component of overall health and well-being for adults and children. Respondents were asked to selected "where do you or your family go when you need dental services?" The largest majority of respondents (95.1%) selected a private dentist. Around 5% of respondents selected "other;" most of these respondents listed going out of Kankakee County for dental services, and several individuals commented they are unable to afford dental services.



Access to adequate prenatal care early in pregnancy results in improved pregnancy outcomes for women and infants. Respondents were asked to select where to access prenatal (pregnancy) care? Over 50% of the respondents selected "not applicable" to this question. Of those that selected another response, 42.2% selected private practice/ health care provider. Around 2% selected "other," comments for this included prenatal services out of this county. Around 2% of the respondents selected the local health department, which provides family case management and WIC services for pregnant women.



Open Responses

Of the respondents, 43 provided comments further explain their selections to the above questions about access to information and health care services. Analysis of the responses identified several themes within the responses, as listed below:

Inadequate Care

Respondents provided comments on negative personal experiences related to health care, and specific services that are inadequate in this county: dental services and obstetric services.

Private Coverage

Around 9% of the respondents provided comments related to private insurance coverage, in which individuals are able to access health care providers.

Access to Care

Close to 7% of the respondents commented on barriers to access to health care services, which include available mental health services, getting an appointment with a private health care provider, and navigating health services with state insurance (Medicaid).






Q2 Do you live in Kankakee County?











Q10 What is your marital status?




























Quality of Life

Sixty three percent of this targeted sample rated quality of life as "good" or "very good," which is about the same as the larger survey sample (60%). This targeted sample rated overall quality of the environment (75% "good" or "very good") higher than the larger sample (66/7%), but rated overall quality of the healthcare system much lower (26.3% "good" or "very good") than the larger sample (55%).




The targeted sample rated questions related to Kankakee County as a place to raise children (45% "good" or "very good") slightly lower than the larger sample (53%). Respondents in this group rated Kankakee County as a place to grow old (30% "good" or "very good") lower than the larger sample (44%), and rated Kankakee County as a safe community (55% "good" or "very good") higher than the larger group (47%).



Open Responses

Of the 20 respondents, 4 individuals provided comments to further explain their selections to the above questions. The overall themes of these comments include the following: more security in schools and the community as a whole is needed to improve safety and reduce violence, and more services for older adults are needed.

Respondents in this targeted sample rated that there are enough jobs in Kankakee County the same as the larger sample (30% "always" or "most of the time"). Respondents in this targeted sample rated the following questions similar to the larger sample: having a sense of community pride (42%; 48% "always" or "most of the time") and having a responsibility to improve the health of my community as the highest (65%; 70% "always" or "most of the time"). The targeted sample rated the following questions much lower than the larger sample: having enough money to pay for needed things (55%; 81% "always" or "most of the time"), the ability to get help from people when needed (55%; 72% "always" or "most of the time"), and able to get health services in the past year (65%; 82% "always" or "most of the time").




Open Responses

Of the respondents, 4 provided comments to further explain their selections to the above questions. The overall themes of these comments include the following: difficulty paying for medications, accessing healthcare services, and lack of jobs.

Health Equity

Overall, the targeted sample of respondents rated having experienced discrimination (one or more times) much higher than the larger sample in most categories. Similar to the larger sample, the respondents from the Hispanic community rated discrimination at work (55%) and on the street/public setting (50%) highest, but this group rated experiencing discrimination getting services as a store or restaurant as very high (50%).



Open Responses

Of the 20 respondents, only 2 individuals provided comments to further explain their selections to the above questions. These comments included experiencing discrimination on the street or in a public setting, and at work for speaking Spanish, and being denied health services due to the type of insurance they carry.

Social Issues


For this targeted sample of Hispanic community members, the most significant social issues in their home are being able to find good jobs, to participate in arts culture, and community events, and to pay for healthcare. There are similarities to the larger sample in which finding good jobs and participation in arts, culture, and community events were identified as significant social issues. In their neighborhood or community, this group identified healthy behaviors among adults, access to healthy foods, and living in a family friendly environment as top social concerns. None of these were identified as priority concerns in the larger sample. For Kankakee


County as a whole, this targeted sample identified healthy behaviors among adults, going to good schools, and those with disabilities having access to needed services as the top three priorities (*see note below). The only similarity to the larger sample is that the larger sample identified living in a safe neighborhood as a high priority social issue for Kankakee County.



The three charts below identified all of the social issues rated among these survey respondents in ranking order. These responses also reflect the social issues that are of least concern to this targeted sample. In their home, respondent rated "always" or "most of the time" to finding the importance in religious or spiritual values, having transportation, and having access to healthy foods. In their neighborhood or community, they rated highest to participating in recreational activities, finding good jobs, and living in affordable housing. In Kankakee County, the respondents rated "always" or "most of the time" the highest to participating in recreational activities, living in affordable housing, and finding the importance in racial/ethnic diversity.









Health Issues


Of the 20 respondents, the more significant health issues in their home were underage drinking, excessive drinking/ alcohol abuse, and depression/ anxiety. In their neighborhood or community, respondents rated dementia/ Alzheimer's disease, illegal drug abuse, and domestic abuse as the most significant health issues. In Kankakee County, dementia/ Alzheimer's disease, illegal drug abuse, and suicide were the highest rated health issues. Although in different ranking order, these issues are very similar to those identified as priority issues in the larger sample. Several significant differences include that suicide in Kankakee County was identified as a top health concern for this targeted sample but not for the larger sample, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs) were rated as a health concern for the larger sample, but not this targeted sample.

In their neighborhood or community and in Kankakee County, respondents were least concerned with STIs, underage drinking, and excessive drinking/alcohol abuse.








Information and Services

Resources


Respondents were asked to select where they get health related information. The top five resources that were selected were very different than the larger sample. The internet was the main source for both groups, but a large portion of these respondents reported going to their family, church, the local health department, and community organizations for health information. Only 5% of this targeted sample obtain health information from a healthcare provider, as compared to 59% of the larger sample.





Access to Healthcare


Of this targeted sample, the respondents selected the hospital emergency department and their healthcare provider 40% of the time. One fourth of the respondents selected Azzarelli outreach clinic, and 20% selected an immediate care/fast care clinic. Of those needing mental health services, the respondents selected Azzarelli Outreach Clinic, a healthcare provider, and a school/work clinic. Most (52.6%) of the respondents seek dental services from a private dentist and 10% indicated Azzarelli Outreach Clinic. Close to 40% selected "other" for dental services, and provide comments that they travel out of county for dental services, and that more affordable dental services are needed within the community. For prenatal (pregnancy) care

services, only 11.8% selected a healthcare provider for services. Close to 30% selected the hospital emergency room, and 6% selected Azzarelli Outreach Clinic. 17% selected "other" and commented on WIC services, which would be through the local health department. Overall, this targeted sample is less likely to access a private practice/ healthcare provider. These respondents are more likely to use the Azzarelli Outreach Clinic or the hospital emergency room for their healthcare needs. 









Targeted Sample: African American Community Members


A targeted focus group of 16 respondents provided additional survey data for African American community members living in Kankakee County. All of the respondents in this sample are non Hispanic, African American, and English is the primary language in their home. Below is the demographic details of this targeted group. (n=16)
















Sixty three percent of this targeted sample rated quality of life as "good" or "very good," which is about the same as the larger survey sample (60%). This targeted sample rated overall quality of the environment (37.6% "good" or "very good") much lower than the larger sample (66.7%), and rated overall quality of the healthcare system much lower (25% "good" or "very good") than the larger sample (55%).




The targeted sample rated questions related to Kankakee County as a place to raise children (63% "good" or "very good") slightly higher than the larger sample (53%). Respondents in this

group rated Kankakee County as a place to grow old (68.8% "good" or "very good") and as a safe community (56.3% "good" or "very good") higher than the larger group (44%; 47%). No comments were provided in this section.



When asked more details related to quality of life, this targeted sample rated having a sense of responsibility to help improve the health of my community (68.8% "always" or "most of the

time") about the same as the larger sample (69.9%). This targeted sample rated having enough money to pay for things I really need (75% "always" or "most of the time") as lower than the larger sample (81%). These respondents rated the following questions higher than the larger sample: there are enough jobs in Kankakee County (37.5% "always" or "most of the time"; 30.4%); I have a sense of community pride (68.8% "always" or "most of the time"; 48.2%); I have people who can help me when I need it (75% "always" or "most of the time"; 71.3%); in the past year, I was able to get the healthcare services I needed (87.5% "always" or "most of the time"; 81.8%).




Open Responses

One individual provided a comment related to quality of life, and commented on the need for better paying jobs in Kankakee County.

Health Equity

Overall, the targeted sample of respondents rated having experienced discrimination (one or more times) much higher than the larger sample. Similar to the larger sample, the respondents from the African American community rated discrimination on the street/public setting (62.5%) very high, but this group also rated getting services as a store or restaurant as very high (62.5%). The third highest rated for experiencing discrimination for this targeted sample was inthe school setting at 40%. No comments were provided in this section.




Social Issues


For this targeted sample of African American community members, the most significant social issues in their home are being able to find good jobs, access to interpreter services (*see note below), and participate in arts culture, and community events. The larger sample also prioritized these same issues in different ranking order. In their neighborhood or community, this group prioritized being able to find a good job/ live in a healthy community, finding the importance of racial/ethnic diversity, and to participate in arts, culture, and community events as significant social issues. Finding jobs and finding importance in racial/ ethnic diversity are also ranked in the top three for the larger sample. For Kankakee County as a whole, this targeted sample of African Americans rated being able to find good jobs, having transportation, and going to good schools as the top three social issues. The only similarity to the larger sample was being able to find good jobs as a high priority social issue for Kankakee County.



The three charts below identify all of the social issues rated among these survey respondents in ranking order. These responses also reflect the social issues that are of least concern to this targeted sample. In their home, respondent rated "always" or "most of the time" to obtaining immunizations, participating in recreational activities, and finding the importance in religious or spiritual values. In their neighborhood or community, they rated highest to living in a clean environment, adults practicing healthy behaviors, and being able to participate in recreational activities. In Kankakee County, the respondents rated "always" or "most of the time" the highest to obtaining immunizations, having access to healthy foods, and being able to participate in recreational activities. No comments were provided in this section.









Health Issues


Of the 16 respondents, the most significant health issues in their home are violence, other mental health issues, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs). The respondents rated the highest health concerns for their neighborhood or community as violence, suicide, and illegal drug abuse. In Kankakee County, other mental health issues, illegal drug abuse, and depression/anxiety were the highest rated health issues. Similarities between the highest rate health concerns for this sample and the larger sample include depression/anxiety, other mental health issues, and illegal drug abuse. It is important to note that violence was rated as the top health concern both in the home and in the neighborhood/ community for this targeted sample, but not ranked as a priority issue for the larger sample.

The charts below provide detailed information on all of the health issues addressed in this survey. The respondents only identified six health issues that were a concern in their home, and all percentages were very low at 6.3%. In their neighborhood, respondents were least concerned with domestic abuse, youth violence, prescription drug abuse. In Kankakee County, the respondents rated youth violence, dementia/ Alzheimer's disease, and prescription drug abuse as the lowest. No comments were provided in this section.








Information and Services

Resources

Respondents were asked to select where they get health related information. Although this targeted sample ranked healthcare provider as their top source for information, both this sample and the larger sample ranked health care provider and the internet as their top two sources. The percentage of respondents that selected family as a source of information was similar for both samples. A higher percentage of this targeted sample selected community organizations and church as sources than the larger sample.



Access to Healthcare

Of this targeted sample, the 87.5% of respondents selected private practice/ healthcare provider. A large percentage (62.5%) also selected the hospital emergency room as a place they would go if they were sick or in need of medical care. Of those needing mental health services, the respondents selected a healthcare provider, the hospital emergency room, and Aunt Martha's Community Health Center. All of the respondents selected a private dentist for dental services. Of those that need prenatal (pregnancy) care, most (69.2%) see a healthcare provider, and very few selected the hospital emergency room (7%) and the local health department (7%). No comments were provided in this section.
