

¹ Provoked bite – bite might be expected given the circumstances (e.g. separating 2 fighting animals, handling unfamiliar animal, taking away an animal's food, running or biking by the dog, entering a dog's property)

² Unprovoked – bite would not be expected given the circumstances (e.g. person walking in the park and dog or cat runs up and bites) 3 Signs of rabies – trouble walking, paralysis or weakness, excess salivation, neurologic problems or extreme aggressiveness
